### Emirate of Granada (last emirate in the Iberian)

The Nasrid dynasty (Arabic: **بنو نصر** *banū Naṣr* or *banū al-Aḥmar*; Spanish: *Nazarí*) was the last Muslim dynasty in the Iberian Peninsula, ruling the Emirate of Granada from 1230 until 1492. Its members claimed to be of Arab origin.

It was started by the Hammudid dynasty in the early 10th century, in the empire **Caliphate of Córdoba**.



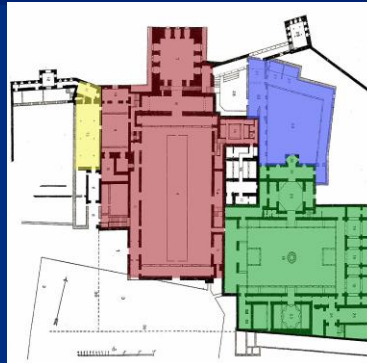
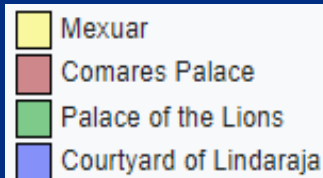
## Generalife 14th century
